Our By-Laws were amended in several places.....

Under Organization, a section was added to read “Any individual, unit, company, troop, or battery assigned, with approval of the Colonel or his designee, to the FNCB shall follow the Rules and Regulations of the FNCB.”

Also, under Section X, part C was amended to read “Period shoes must be worn at all times.”

The Safety Rules were amended to read that there would be no preparation of cartridges (rolling of rounds) in camp.

It was noted that the Canadians are erecting a monument to those Canadians who served in the Civil War. A donation of \$400 was made to that effort with the consideration of additional donations in 2016.
